

Riverdale School Board Petitions Available

Nominating petitions for the *April 4, 2017* School Board Election for Riverdale Community Unit School District #100 will be available for circulation on *September 20, 2016*. Forms may be picked up at the Rock Island County Office Building, 1504 Third Avenue, Rock Island, Illinois, 61201, on business days between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

A School Board candidate's petition must be filed in the same office no earlier than 8:00 a.m., *December 12, 2016* and no later than 5:00 p.m., *December 19, 2016*.

Candidates' names will appear on the election ballot in the order in which their nominating papers are received at the Rock Island County Office Building.

Four seats on the seven-member Board of Education will be filled at the election, serving four-year terms.

Membership on the Board of Education is restricted to a maximum of (3) members from any congressional township. Based on existing Board membership, members may be elected as follows: (1) Coe, (2) Zuma, (3) Canoe Creek, Port Byron, Hampton, and Cordova.

To be eligible to serve, a School Board member must be, on the date of election, a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years old, a registered voter, and a resident of the State of Illinois and the school district for at least one year immediately preceding the election.
